General Local Election 2018

MAIL BALLOT APPLICATION

Mail ballot voting is available to:

- Persons who have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity for this election; **OR**
- Persons who expect to be absent from the Municipality at the time of the advance voting opportunities (October 10 and 17, 2018) and on general voting day (October 20, 2018).

NOTE: You will be required to certify your entitlement to vote by mail ballot.

To be a qualified elector, you must meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on October 20, 2018; **AND**
- A Canadian citizen; **AND**
- A resident of the District of Oak Bay for at least the past 30 days **OR** a non-resident owner of real property within the District of Oak Bay for at least the past 30 days; **AND**
- A resident of BC for at least the past 6 months; **AND**
- Not disqualified by law from voting in an election.

1. Complete this form and mail or deliver in person to the Municipal Clerk's Office, District of Oak Bay, 2167 Oak Bay Avenue, Victoria, BC V8R 1G2, or fax to 250-598-9108, **between Wednesday, September 26 and Thursday, October 18, 2018 by 4:00 p.m.**
2. If your application form is filled out correctly, the Chief Election Officer will send you a mail ballot package commencing on or about October 10, 2018. (If we receive your application after October 10th and time may not permit mailing, you should arrange to pick up a package from the Municipal Clerks' Office, Oak Bay Municipal Hall.)
3. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer at the Oak Bay Municipal Hall, 2167 Oak Bay Avenue, Victoria, BC V8R 1G2, no later than **8:00 p.m. on General Voting Day, Saturday, October 20th, 2018.**

PLEASE NOTE: Once a mail ballot package has been accepted by the Chief Election Officer, you cannot vote at the regular or advance voting opportunities.
