Player Code of Conduct

Oak Bay Recreation is committed to a sport and a work environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity.

Harassment is one or a series of incidents or behaviors directed at a group or individual that a reasonable person ought to know would cause offence, humiliation or intimidation.

Oak Bay Recreation encourages all players, officials and administrative staff to adhere to the Players Code of Conduct below, so all individuals feel safe and respected while participating in and working with this league.

- Disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated. League members found to have engaged in conduct constituting harassment/discrimination may be suspended.
 - Harassment may occur in the arena, the dressing rooms, and the office.
 - This may occur through any forms of communication device/system including but not limited to in person conversation, telephone calls, text message and email.

As a player in the Oak Bay Adult Hockey League, I agree to not:

- Use offensive and foul language, on or off the ice, to other players, officials or the league administration and front desk staff.
- Participate in any physical or verbal abuse, or harassment.
- Criticize teammates. Players are expected to be supportive of their teammates.
- Taunt or incite opposing players.
