APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Submit your application at Oak Bay Recreation Centre, 1975 Bee Street, Victoria, V8R 5E6 or email to recreationjobs@oakbay.ca Applications must be received by 4:00pm, Monday, January 29, 2024.
- 2. Applicants will be considered for all positions for which they are qualified. If you only want to be considered for specific positions, please indicate on the application form.
- 3. Late applications will be considered after applications received by closing date are processed.
- 4. Applicants will be contacted by e-mail if they are selected for an interview. Please ensure your e-mail address is clearly printed on the application form and please add humanresources@oakbay.ca to your safe list for incoming e-mails. We regret that we are only able to contact shortlisted applicants.

HIRING PROCESS

- Shortlisted applicants will be contacted by e-mail by Friday, February 2, 2024. Interviews will be conducted between February 6-9, 2024.
- Only shortlisted applicants will be required to provide an original Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening dated within one year, to be presented to Human Resources by Friday, March 1, 2024. (Note: It is the applicants financial responsibility to obtain this.)
- 3. Current and returning staff: please check with Human Resources to see if your Police Information check will need to be renewed.
- 4. Training will be held within March 5-13, 2024 time frame. This is a paid session and must be attended.
- 5. Short-listed applicants (including current staff) will be required to bring original certificates to the interview. Specific certifications required are listed with each position.
