A Bylaw to authorize the use of the municipal ticket information system

WHEREAS Division 3 of Part 8 of the *Community Charter* authorizes a municipal council by bylaw:

- Amendment Bylaw 4248, 2004*
- A. to designate bylaws which may be enforced by means of a form of ticket prescribed by regulation under the *Community Charter*;
 - B. to designate bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of enforcing bylaws by means of a prescribed form of ticket;
 - C. to designate an offence against a bylaw by means of a word or expression on a ticket;
 - D. to establish penalties not exceeding an amount prescribed by regulation under the *Community Charter*;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Oak Bay, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Division 3 of Part 8 of the *Community Charter*.

2. The persons acting in the capacities listed in Column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers pursuant to Division 3 of Part 8 of the *Community Charter* for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 opposite the respective capacities.

3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules 2 through 21 of this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.

4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules 2 through 21 to this Bylaw are the fines set pursuant to Division 3 of Part 8 of the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.

- 4.1 In the case of a continuing offence, the fines referred to in Section 4 may be imposed for each day that the offence continues.

- 4.2 In this Bylaw, a reference to a provision of the *Community Charter* means a provision of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C., 2003, c. 26, and includes a like provision in an amendment or successor statute providing a legal framework for local government in the Province of British Columbia.

5. Bylaw 3657, being the "Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw, 1990" and all amendments thereto, are hereby repealed, provided however, that such repeals shall not affect the validity of any tickets issued prior to the adoption of this Bylaw.
6. This Bylaw may be cited as the "**TICKET INFORMATION UTILIZATION BYLAW, 1997**".
7. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
