## 3) Reports:

- a) Executive update (Michelle Le Sage):
  - i) Welcome & Introduction of New Committee Members...
  - ii) Michelle gave some background to the OBT committee and how it is funded (MRDT tax collected by OBBH and OBGH). OBBH is now collecting an additional 1% tax (DMF) which is contributed to Tourism Victoria and opens the doors to more direct collaboration with them.
  - iii) Michelle introduced the OBT Funding Application Form (draft). This document aims to formalize the process for applying for funding and help clarify what the event brings to Oak Bay Tourism and how it fits into the funding model

#### iv) Website domain update

 Hothouse currently owns the domain <u>oakbaytourism.ca</u> they are happy to hand it over to OBT. Tom to ask if it can be moved over and come under the municipality.

#### b) Finance (Brian Dolsen):

- i) Revenue for 2017 is approx. \$150,000 plus the surplus from last year. Full financials will be available in March.
- c) Destinations Development & Community Relations (Ken Agate):
  - i) Met in December and invited new members who all subsequently joined the full committee. Discussed old Kiwanis kiosk being updated at Municipal Hall, some of the mixers and trade shows that we want to attend. Reviewed plan. Talked about last year's achievements.

## d) Marketing (Michelle/Kira):

- Michelle presented the media updates from the recent travel writers who stayed here and some of the promotions they ran at OBBH
- ii) OBT is hosting/sponsoring the meeting planners group who are staying at the OBBH this weekend Fri-Sun and visiting local businesses in the area. The aim is to showcase Oak Bay as a place to bring people for meetings.
- iii) Writing contest has been launched and ads have appeared in local papers. So far about 12 pieces have been submitted. We have until Mar 20th and would like to see 30-40 submissions.
- iv) OBBH negotiating with Tourism Victoria to include Oak Bay on their Circle Routes

# e) Council Liaison report (Tom Croft/ Hazel Braithwaite)

- i) Tom presented the OBT marketing plan to the Council at their meeting and the budget was approved. New members have received notification of place on OBT committee. Sign on the Kiwanis Kiosk may have some heritage status so need to check with Heritage committee before looking at any changes.
- Oak Bay will not be hosting the Mayors caucus this year, it will be hosted in Squamish

- iii) Saturday before Mother's Day (May 10th) is the "Spring Nosh up"
- iv) Hazel will book space for OBT tent/bike at the next Oak Bay Tea Party
