## MAYOR'S REMARKS:

## 2. Mayor's Remarks

The CAO introduced Joanna Winter, who has been retained as the District's Corporate Services Advisor / Interim Deputy Director of Corporate Services while recruitment for the Director of Corporate Services position is underway.

Mayor Murdoch acknowledged the Oak Bay Community Association and all of the hard work by participants in the recent beach clean-up. The Mayor officially welcomed the new Police Chief Ray Bernoties and Deputy Chief Mark Fisher. Mayor Murdoch advised that he will be presenting long service awards to several volunteers, and acknowledged the hundreds of volunteers making our community better. The Mayor provided an update on the Oak Bay Lodge and the recent decision by Island Health and BC Housing that a temporary housing solution is not possible due to the condition of the building and the support services needed. He advised that there is an active redevelopment project underway on this property and that consultation would be starting shortly for the project which is proposed to include significant health care services and housing.

Mayor invited members of the public to call into the meeting to provide input to Council. The CAO advised that the live webcasting was not functioning correctly.
