Progressive dinner is planned. Ocean River Kayaks has rentals at the OB Marina including kayaks, rowboats, stand up paddling.
 - Community Relations (Tom Croft chair): Working with Oak Bay news to increase tourism communication. A tourism code of ethics is needed. Kiosk plan to sit in front of OB municipal hall.
 - Marketing (Kris Morash chair): Social media posting requires further expansion. All 2015 print ads complete with some published and others to be released during the next two weeks. Web site development requires alignment with print ads.
 - Special Project update (Angus Matthews): Review and discussion regarding choice
 of branding logo and tag line. Consensus achieved with "Picture Perfect". Angus to
 obtain advice from Hot House regarding fonts; upper or lower.
