EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend that the Committee of the Whole recommend to Council that the attached Terms of Reference for the Review of Council Committees and Commissions be approved.

BACKGROUND

From a municipal government perspective it is best practice to regularly review governance structures, including committees and commissions. Most commonly these types of reviews are initiated following municipal elections and/or after adoption of strategic plans. The primary goals are to ensure (1) effective governance; and (2) that the time and efforts of volunteer community members and staff are respected and maximized. The purpose of Commissions and Committees are to assist Council and the community in providing good governance and accomplishing Council's strategic priorities and objectives. There are many different committee/commission models and a review of Oak Bay's structure is appropriate at this time.

Attachment "1" outlines the proposed Terms of Reference for this initiative. A small consulting budget is included in the Financial Plan to assist in the completion of this project.

Terms of Reference

The District of Oak Bay is seeking to undertake a review and assessment of its current Council committee and commission structure to ensure effective governance and that the time and efforts of its volunteer community members and staff are maximized.

The review and assessment of the current Council committee and commission structure will include an analysis of the following:

- existing terms of reference and bylaws that outline the mandate of and delegate authority to the committees and commissions
- establishment history of current committees and commissions
- how the existing structure aligns with the Financial and Strategic Plans
- how existing policies, procedures and bylaws, e.g., Procedure Bylaw, support the existing structure
- committee/commission workplans
- committee/commission membership including appointment and recruitment processes
- · member orientation and support
- · meeting schedule and agenda items
- staff resources and support: agendas, reports, minutes, record keeping, follow-up
- Council liaison and how recommendations/decisions are reported back to Council
 - o impact on Council decision-making process
- community engagement and public input
 - o i.e., how the existing structure is utilized to receive public input
- committee and commission structures in similar sized municipalities

Consultation with all affected stakeholders, i.e. Council, staff, committee/commission members etc., is expected.

Upon completion of the review and assessment of the existing Council committee and commission structure, a report will be prepared for Council consideration recommending any changes to the existing structure, functions and processes that would allow Council to govern more effectively and support the organization as a whole.
