# THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF OAK BAY

## BYLAW NO. 4846

A Bylaw to designate bylaws to be enforced by means of the municipal ticket information system.

---

WHEREAS the *Community Charter*, SBC 2003, c 26 authorizes the Council, by bylaw, to designate those bylaws for which municipal ticket information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

AND WHEREAS the *Community Charter*, SBC 2003, c 26 authorizes the Council to, by by-law, set the fine amounts of each municipal ticket information;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District Oak Bay, in Open Meeting Assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

### **Bylaws enforced by ticket**

1. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of section 264(1) of the *Community Charter*.

### **Bylaw enforcement officers**

2. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule 1 are designated as bylaw enforcement officers under section 264(1)(b) of the *Community Charter*.

### **Description of offences**

3. Pursuant to section 264(4) of the *Community Charter*, the words, expressions or general description set out in Column 1 of Schedules 2 through 29 designate the offence committed under the bylaw section appearing under Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.

### **Set fines**

4. Pursuant to section 265(1) of the *Community Charter*, the amounts appearing under Column 3 of Schedules 2 through 29 are fines set for corresponding offences designated in Column 1 of each Schedule.

- 4.1 In the case of a continuing offence, the fines referred to in Section 4 may be imposed for each day that the offence continues.

### **Reduced fines**

5. The amounts appearing under Column 4 of Schedules 2 through 29 to this Bylaw are the discounted fines pursuant to section 265(2) of the *Community Charter* for the corresponding fines set in Column 3 of each Schedule provided that the Municipal Ticket Information is paid within 30 calendar days upon receipt.

### **Repeal**

6. “**Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 3952, 1997**”, and all its amendments are hereby repealed.

### **Title**

7. This Bylaw may be cited as “**Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 4846, 2023**”.
