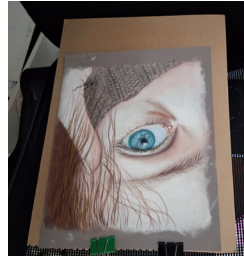

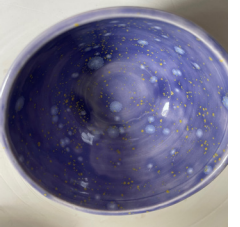
Avis Rasmussen

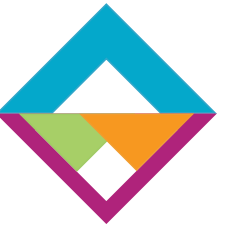


Arlene Davey

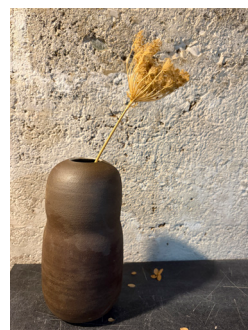
