

Notice of Work– August 27, 2026

McNeill Bay Monterey Avenue Storm Outfall Repair

What's Happening:

Beach access at Monterey Avenue and Beach Drive is closed due to erosion around the headwall of the storm outfall. The stairs will remain closed until the design and construction are complete.

The work, starting Thursday, August 27, involves the installation of a pipe liner inside the existing storm pipe. This will restore the structural integrity of the storm main pipe, sealing the pipe and reducing erosion from behind the headwall while minimizing disruption to the surrounding area.

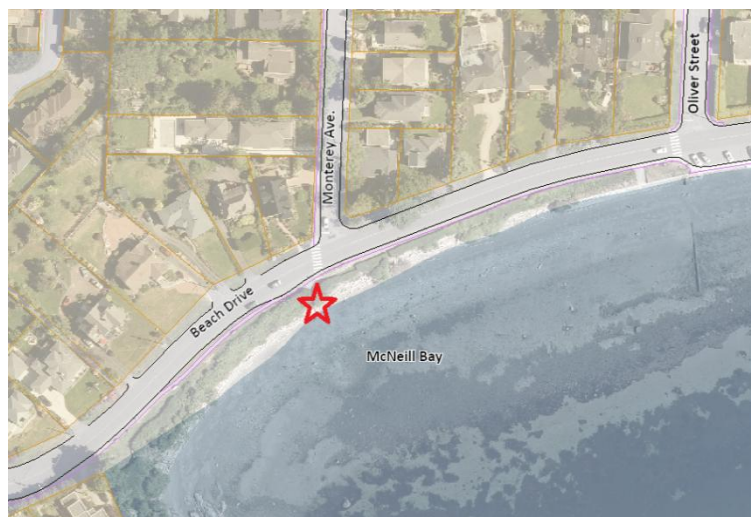
Date of Work:

The work starts August 27, 2026, and is anticipated to be completed in two days.

Traffic/Impacts:

- Work will be performed from the road surface on Beach Drive, with minimal work taking place on the beach .
- Typical hours of work are expected between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- The sidewalk will remain open.
- Signage will be posted to assist pedestrians and cyclists navigating the area.
- Possible delays through the construction site should be expected.
- Please exercise caution when walking through site.
