



Where Can I Place an Election Sign?

Below, you'll find tips on where you can place your election sign. Signs are only permitted from September 11 until end of day October 21, 2026.



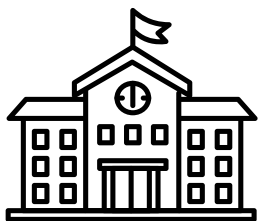
Private Property



Election signs may be placed on boulevards in front of private property, **with resident permission**



Election signs are **restricted** on **all other boulevards** unless identified in Schedule A of Sign Bylaw, 1997



Public Property

Election Signs are prohibited on municipal property, parks, fences, trees, streetlights and traffic signal poles and on boulevards **unless identified in Schedule A of the Sign Bylaw, 1997.**

Quick Tips

Only two signs per candidate permitted in each designated area

Election signs on municipal boulevards are not to exceed 2x2 feet.

No signs are permitted within 100 metres of any voting place on any voting days, including advance voting.
